ARRIVET Magazine: Applied Research Results in Vocational Education & Training

ARRIVET is an international, interdisciplinary publication dedicated to the documentation and dissemination of applied research results. Its focus is on the application of research to the solution of business and industry problems, and the use of applied research in vocational learning and teaching. Its audience includes those who are interested in solving practical research problems of business and industry, with particular focus on those committed to the dialogue between production and instruction, the professional and the vocational.

ARRIVET was launched in 2023 and publishes articles from applied research practitioners around the world. Initially there will be one publication annually, in an electronic format, online, and open source.

ARRIVET is a collaborative production of the World Federation of Colleges and Polytechnics Applied Research and Innovation Affinity Group and will be published and produced by Tknika, the advanced vocational training centre in Basque Country, Spain.

ARRIVET is inviting researchers, academics, professionals, practitioners, and postgraduate students to submit original articles in the broad area of applied research for vocational education and training. We welcome articles in the following categories:

- a. Research Results – applied research findings from projects undertaken by VETs.
- b. Research Practices – applied research approaches leading to results and principles.
- c. Research in Context – geographies of applied research and their results.
- d. Training for Research – activities in preparation for applied research and its results.
- e. Training for Vocations – the “applied research/training for vocation nexus” including applied research in pedagogy, building teacher capacity, learning development, and building student capacity.

Submission must be online through the <https://arrivet.org> site.

Guidelines

Articles will be original work, not previously published, not under review for other publication.

- ✓ Articles should be between 3 and 10 typeset pages (not including Abstract)
 - a. For Research Results – applied research findings from projects undertaken by VETs, **five to ten pages**.
 - b. For Research Practices – applied research approaches leading to results and principles, **three to five pages**.
 - c. For Research in Context – geographies of applied research and their results, **five to ten pages**.
 - d. For Training for Research – activities in preparation for applied research and its results, **three to five pages**.
 - e. For Training for Vocations – the “applied research/training for vocation nexus” including applied research in pedagogy, building teacher capacity, learning development, and building student capacity, **five to ten pages**.

Articles should include a title paragraph that shows all author(s)' affiliations and contact information, identifying the corresponding author with an asterisk.

Large Language Models (LLMs), such as ChatGPT, do not satisfy our authorship criteria.

- ✓ The abstract should be no more than 200 words.
- ✓ For the main body of the text, there are no specific requirements. However, structure might include, Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion. The main body of text should be followed by: References, Data availability, Figure legends, Tables. No footnotes should be used.

Review Process

Each article submitted to this issue will be subject to the following review procedures:

- All papers will receive a plagiarism check, and once accepted will be forwarded for editorial examination, and blind or peer review if needed.
- At least two reviewers will be selected for this review process for general suitability for the publication.
- Reviewers will decide to accept, revise, or reject. If you have been invited to revise your paper, please use the link provided in the decision letter to resubmit.
- Once accepted, papers will pass onto production process.
- Acceptance does not guarantee publication in the issue.

Formatting

Title paragraph (Calibri 12):

- Paper title – centred and bolded.
- Author name(s), Author(s) affiliation, and Abstract (200 words) – left aligned.
- Keywords (maximum of 3) – left aligned.

Main document (Calibri 12):

- Page set-up – 3cm margins.
- Headings – all capitals and bolded.
- Sub-headings – bolded.
- Text – 1.5 spaced with 6-point spacing before each paragraph.
- All titles and paragraphs – separated by a 1.5 spaced before and after.
- Please number all pages.

Referencing (Calibri 12):

- All references should be in the APA-7 Format, no footnotes.

Tables, figures and images (Calibri 12):

- Maximum one page of tables, figures, or images.
- Tables, figures, and images should be clearly labelled and numbered.
- In numbering figures and tables, please use the same section's numbering code.
- All tables, figures and images should be submitted in MSWORD format as an appendix separate from the main body of the article.
